THE RULES

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Breeder's/Family, Open or Working Conformation.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the Committee may enter their Terriers in any phase of the competition.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. ***Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.***
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed. Flexi-leashes are strongly discouraged!
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655), or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. **Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated.** Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
23. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.**

- **NO FLEXI LEADS** - 4' or 6' leashes only permitted on trial site. Be mindful of where your dog is at all times.
- A copy of your **2019 JRTCA Membership** card must be submitted with your entries, faxed before the trial or shown at the entry table. If you have not done one of the above, you will NOT be allowed to compete.
- **Copies of Certificates in Championship GTG, Super Earth, Agility and Working terriers must be submitted with entry forms.**
- **Children MUST be supervised by an adult at all times. **KEEP TERRIERS AWAY FROM THE REGISTRATION TABLE!****

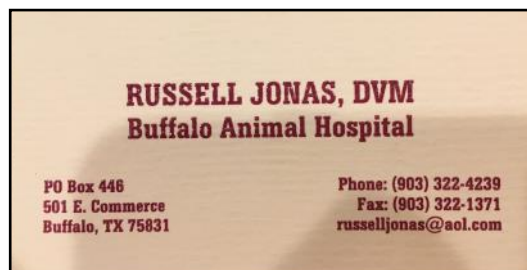
Please travel with your health records for ALL of your terriers and have a signed rabies certificate from your vet.

- **Homemade concession food** (breakfast & lunch) is available at site - catered by Cindy
- **ABSOLUTELY no puppies under 3 months.** Questions as to age of puppies will be resolved in favor of the puppies' general well-being, and you will be asked to remove them from the trial site, including RV area.
- **Well-behaved and restrained "alternative breeds" may attend with approval from a Trial Administrator;** however, they will not be allowed within any posted area, or within 50 feet of any event so as not to disturb the exhibitors. Please contact the Trial Administrator for permission.
- **Exhibitors must sign the waiver when submitting entry forms.**
- **No refunds** will be given for missed classes. **Pay attention, and if you need help handling dogs...ask for it.**
- **Any exhibitor found to be in violation of any of these policies will be disqualified and no refund given.**
- **No grooming at ringside!!** Please limit grooming at the trial site. Grooming at hotels/motels is not allowed.

The Leon County Expo Center trial site is located on 3637 County Road 305 in Buffalo, TX 75831. Fairgrounds Manager - Gene Darby (903-390-8313). Call Jean Wallwin or David Dernick if you need directions or have a question.

From Houston Intercontinental Airport - Depart towards Terminal Road S., 0.1 miles; bear right onto Terminal Road S., 0.2 miles; bear right onto JFK Blvd/John F. Kennedy Blvd, 2.3 miles; take ramp on right and follow signs for Pay Toll/Hardy Toll Road (Toll road, stop for tolls), 2.9 miles; take ramp on right for Hardy Toll Road North toward the Woodlands, 11.9 miles; keep straight onto I-45 North, 91.4 miles; at exit 164, take ramp right for TX-7 towards Centerville, 0.3 miles; turn right onto TX-7/W Saint Mary's Street, 0.5 miles; turn left onto TX-75/N. Commer Street, 9.2 miles; turn left onto County Road 305—0.1 miles.

From Austin - Depart Presidential Blvd. toward Cardinal Loop, 0.9 miles; take ramp on right and follow sign for TX-71 East, 1.7 miles; take ramp left for TX-130-Toll North/TX-45 Toll North toward Waco (Toll Road, stop for tolls), 20.8 miles; keep straight onto TX-130 N. Toll, 4.6 miles, at exit 423, take ramp on right toward Round Rock/Taylor, 0.7 miles; turn right onto road, 0.1 miles, take ramp on left and follow signs for US-79 North (pass Ford/Chevrolet in 3.1 miles), 6.5 miles; keep straight onto US-79 E TRUCK, 2.0 miles; take ramp on right for US-79 North toward Rockdale (pass Shell in 5.3 miles), 54.1 miles; take ramp on right for US-79 North/TX-6/S. Market Street, 1.9 miles; keep left to stay on US-79 E/TX-6S, 438 ft; keep left onto US-79 N/TX-6 S., 0.1 miles; road name changes to US-79 EAST/TX-6 SOUTH (pass Exxon in 10.8 miles), 0.2 miles; bear right onto TX-75/S. Buffalo Avenue, 6.4 miles; turn right onto County Road 305.

From Dallas Love Field Airport, Dallas, TX - Depart Cedar Springs Rd/Herb Kelleher Way toward Contrail, 1.1 miles; turn left onto W. Mockingbird Lane (Shell Station on corner), 385ft; take ramp left and follow signs for Dallas North Tollway South (Toll road/stop for tolls), 2.4 miles; Take ramp on right and follow signs for N. Stemmons Freeway, 0.7 miles; At exit 428A, take ramp left for I-30 East towards Texarkana, 1.3 miles; At exit 46, take ramp right for I-45 South toward Houston, 105.6 miles; At exit 180, take ramp right for TX-164 toward Groesbeck, 0.3 miles; Turn left onto TX-164, 1.2 miles; Bear right onto TX-75/N. Buffalo Avenue, 6.9 miles; turn right onto County Road 305 - 0.1 miles.

(30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter, work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving the quarry, may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES

Class 130/310 Over 12.5" up to 15" CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 1 yr. & over which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Adult Under GTG Champion & Reserve.

Class 131/311 10" up to 12.5" VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under GTG Champion & Reserve.

Class 132/312 Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over GTG Champion & Reserve.

Class 133/313 10" up to 12.5" SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between certificate Classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Under GTG Champion & Reserve.

Class 134/314 Over 12.5" up to 15" SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Over GTG Champion & Reserve.

DIVISION G: SUPER EARTH (CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES)

Class 143/323 10" up to 12.5" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 6 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 144/324 Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 6 years or older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 145/325 10" up to 12.5" SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 146/326 Over 12.5" up to 15" SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

This course is used for Youth Agility On-Lead. No see-saw or tire jump in this class. **May not cross-enter into 147/327 & 148/328.**

Class 150/330 Jumpers/Game – Off-lead. Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. 15 faults for missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg towards a JRTCA Jumpers/Game Certificate.

Class 151/331 AGILITY HIGH SCORE CHAMPION & RESERVE To be awarded to the high score terrier and runner-up combining scores of Agility II, Agility III and qualifying no fault score in Jumpers/Game (**Classes 147,148,150/327,328,330**). Ties are broken by fastest time. **No entry fee.**

Section 2 Agility On-Lead Classes (ABSOLUTELY NO FLEXI-LEADS)

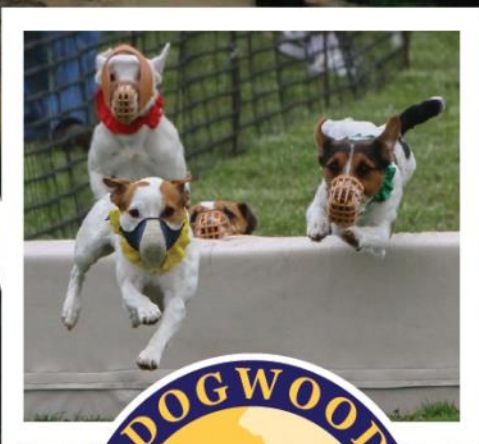

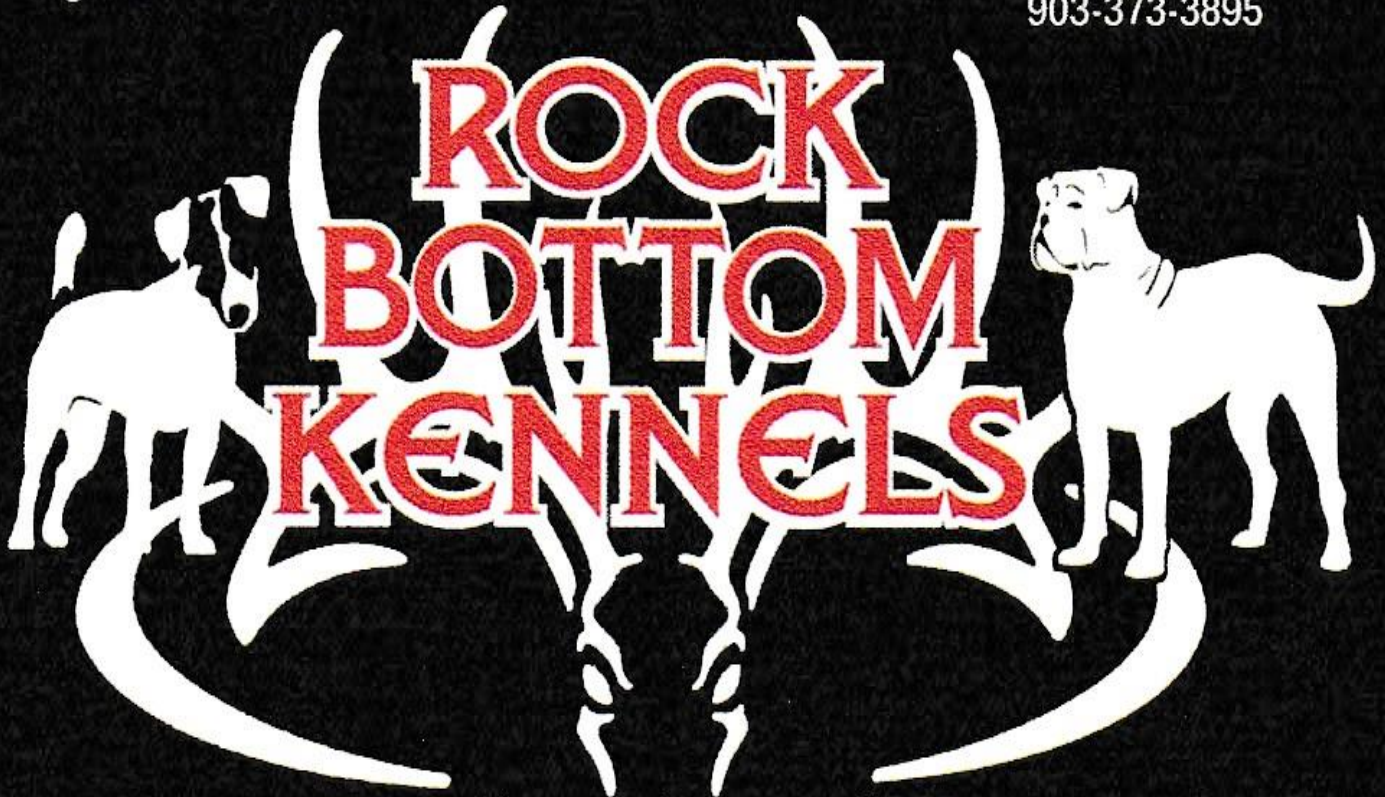
